# Program Request - Abbreviated Template Dixie State University Certificate of Proficiency in Multimedia Journalism 09/16/16

Section I: Request

This request is for the addition of the Certificate of Proficiency in Multimedia Journalism to the curriculum of the Department of Media Studies at Dixie State University. The department currently offers a Bachelor's Degree in Media Studies, with emphases in Media Studies, Strategic Communication, Multimedia Journalism, and Social Media. Therefore, courses taught as a part of this certificate are already being offered by the department. Furthermore, the department has access to production facilities for content that will be a part of this program's requirements. The addition of the certificate will add options to those students who wish to gain additional experience that will supplement a degree that they are earning or have already earned, or additionally, those students who are wishing to gain knowledge in the field without obtaining a degree. The proposed program will give these opportunities without significantly impacting instructional activities, apart from increasing enrollment.

Section II: Need

Like many other industries, the journalism industry has undergone changes with the proliferation of newer media forms. Social media, video for the web, and smart phone app technology have become commonplace. Yet, many journalists do not have the technical knowledge to create the kind of content required in the industry. The proposed certificate is designed to provide this proficiency. Furthermore, the certificate program is designed to provide proficiency in journalism production for those wishing to be entrepreneurial journalists or citizen journalists.

#### Section III: Institutional Impact

The proposed program will provide an opportunity for students who do not wish to earn a Bachelor's Degree in Media Studies but who wish to receive proof of proficiency in multimedia journalism. Some students will choose to receive the certificate without continuing on through the Bachelor's program. Although this could affect the number of students matriculated into the Bachelor's program, the number can be offset by encouraging those students, and other students who would never have come to Dixie for a degree, to continue on in their educational pursuits by obtaining the Bachelor's degree.

The proposed program does not require additional administration. Furthermore, the impact on the institution will be very positive. Currently, the Department of Media Studies has use of media production equipment for producing journalism, both broadcast and on the web, and other media content. The proposed program will put this equipment to good use: training students in journalism production. Finally, the content produced by these students will be used to benefit the institution and the surrounding community by providing news content for consumption by the public.
